MCI/Nova Articulated Fan Trip Saturday, May 26th, 2012

After almost 20 years of service, the end of the line is near for the **MCI/Nova Classic articulated buses** that are operated by Metro Transit. With only 16 buses ever produced (14 bought by Metro and 2 by Quebec City), these buses are among the rarest Canadian vehicles ever made.

The CTHF is planning a six hour fan trip aboard one of the only high floor articulated buses active in Canada. The fan trip will include numerous photo stops, a lunch stop and hopefully a tour of the new Ragged Lake garage, where the artic's are currently allocated.
